Tooth Extractions:

- Some bleeding is normal following tooth extraction. Applying gentle pressure for 20-30 minutes by biting on a sterile gauze pad or a tea bag will help control bleeding. Repeat as needed.
- Take prescription medication and/or analgesic tablets as directed by your dentist or oral surgeon.
- Avoid disturbing the extraction site. Chew on the opposite side for 24 hours. Do not drink carbonated beverages, lie down flat, spit, smoke or suck liquids through a straw.
- Apply an ice pack to the outside of the face, next to the extraction site to help control soreness and swelling. Alternate 20 minutes on and 20 minutes off.
- Brush and floss gently. Avoid all rinsing with mouthwash for 24 hours after extraction. Rinse with warm salty water after 24 hours

Amalgam (sliver) or Composite (white) Restorations (fillings):

- Do not bite hard or chew on new amalgam fillings the same day they are placed.
 Composite fillings are already set, and chewing is permissible.
- Rinse your mouth with warm, salty water to relieve any soreness in gums.
- Exercise care in chewing until numbness from injection wears off. Children especially, should be monitored closely.
- If you experience sensitivity to cold following restoration, It should subside within two to three days. If sensitivity persists, contact our office.
